Saudi Aid Platform 🍃

KSrelief developed this platform to register the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia's projects and humanitarian, developmental and charitable contributions based on the international standards of the United Nations Financial Tracking System (UNFTS), DAC-OECD and the International Aid Transparency Initiative (IATI). The Kingdom's foreign aid is provided in the form of cash, in-kind grants and concessional loans to promote sustainable Development. It also includes commitments and disbursements. Saudi entities have been trained to classify and input the Kingdom's foreign aid to date, from the time of the country's establishment.

Utilizing volunteers is one of the seven principles of carrying out humanitarian work; many organizations and agencies working in the humanitarian field are keen to include volunteers in the implementation of their programs and projects. KSrelief is a channel through which individuals in Saudi Arabia can become involved in volunteer service related to the Kingdom's international humanitarian aid delivery. The center is committed to training and empowering volunteers to the benefit of vulnerable communities; KSrelief's volunteer program also strives to help achieve one of the Kingdom's "Vision 2030" goals: that of building a culture of volunteerism in Saudi Arabia. The platform was launched in order to enable those interested to easily apply for and become involved in a wide range of volunteer opportunities.
