BUILDING 3,000 HOUSING UNITS FOR EARTHQUAKE VICTIMS IN SYRIA & TURKEY

In February 2023, earthquakes struck northern and western Syria and southern and central Turkey, causing massive damage and affecting millions of people, many of whom were left homeless by the disaster. Saudi Arabia has implemented many initiatives to support the earthquake victims, including the National Campaign for Earthquake Victims in Syria and Turkey.

REHABILITATION OF HOUSES DAMAGED BY FLOODS IN SUDAN

Large parts of Sudan were severely damaged due to torrential rains and flooding that occurred in September 2020. The number of fully damaged houses reached 55,286, with another 56,458 partially damaged. To address this issue, KSrelief provided assistance by constructing housing units to create permanent shelters for the most vulnerable families who lost their homes and had been living out in the open in crude shelters under difficult conditions.

The project location was the Tokar area on the Red Sea State a part of the country where some of the poorest and most vulnerable people live. Some 12,075 people were severely affected by the flooding.

The housing units that were built were equipped with fans, internal and external lighting, and electric sockets powered by solar energy. Solar energy panels and units were installed for each room.

The Saudi Village also includes a school in the village to provide education for the children housed there, along with two health care clinics providing residents with medical services.
